Jesse came to the trail industry from a bushwalking background, and has brought that love of the outdoors to all his work in the last 25 years. He became known in the 1990s for his work as Coordinator of the highly acclaimed Building a Better Bibbulmun Track Project which transformed WA's long distance walk trail into a national icon and a long trail of international significance. In more recent years he has gone on to become a major contributor to trail development right across Australia.

Beyond his deep understanding of strategic planning for trails he has particular skills in the areas of user-group needs, trail design and construction, community consultation, resolution of neighbouring landowner concerns, promotion and information literature and resource raising.

His trail skills have been honed by years of experience on trails of a vast variety of types and standards. This instinctive 'feel' for a trail's requirements has been augmented by years of construction experience, in Australia and the USA and his capacity to produce detailed and appropriate trail plans, designs and parameters is unmatched in Australia.
